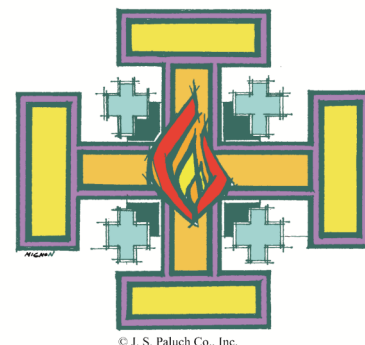

From our Pastor...

It felt good to reopen the church to worshippers last weekend on the feast of Corpus Christi. Watching Mass on television (even though Cardinal Cupich may be presiding from Holy Name Cathedral) or streaming the liturgy on your computer is just not the same as being there physically present with a faith community. Over 200 worshippers came to our four Masses (about 50 per Mass) as we recalled the importance of receiving the body of Christ in our lives! I'd like to thank those volunteers who made our reopening possible by helping us on our "certification committee." We could use more volunteers (either at weekday or Sunday Masses) to greet, usher, sign in, or help sanitize the pews afterwards.



As our restaurants, stores, and parks gradually reopen, I would hope that more of our parishioners would 'venture out' and attend Mass. Even those who are elderly or in the 'high risk' category can be assured that we are making every effort to keep everyone safe as they worship together! Especially this weekend as we celebrate Father's Day! As we watch our "curve flatten" here in Illinois, we are heartened to see fewer daily deaths listed due to the coronavirus.

We have in a real way been facing death each day the last three months: we have been facing our mortality as we battle this terrible pandemic. Paul in Romans today seems to understand our predicament when he says, "Through one man sin entered the world, and through sin, death and thus death came to all men inasmuch as all sinned..." This sounds a lot like the definition of "original sin": Adam and Eve's sin that we inherit as members of the human race, something we've experienced most poignantly during this recent pandemic!

Paul goes on to explain, however, that the 'long reign of Adam's sin' comes to an end with Christ Who overcomes sin and death (and all strains of virus)! We are not afraid then to admit that we are "Christ people", that we trust in the power of the Lord to prevail. Matthew tells us, "Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather be afraid of the one who can destroy both body and soul in Gehenna. (Mt 10:29) God knows each of us personally and intimately ("All the hairs of your head are counted.....and not one of these little sparrows falls to the ground without God's care")

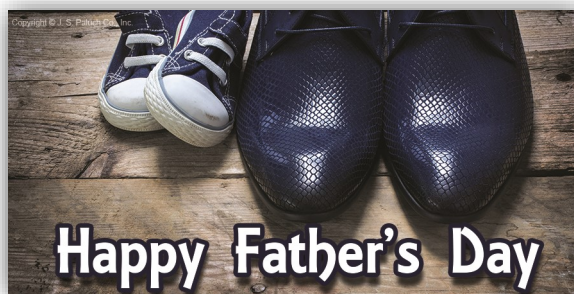
These months of self-containment have given us pause to reflect on the blessings that the Lord has bestowed upon us, among which are our families, our homes, our faith, etc. This disruption in the normal pattern of our lives has also given us the opportunity to re-evaluate our priorities in life (especially in the face of our mortality). One woman told me, "Father, I have not been a very good Catholic or churchgoer but when the parish opens again, I have decided to turn things around!" She was there last Sunday at the 9:30AM Mass!

This time of self-quarantine also has forced us to re-examine our consciences in terms of how we treat one another---our sins against charity in acceptance of people not like ourselves especially persons who have been brutalized or discriminated against because of the color of their skin. We may have not been responsible for specific sins and acts of violence --but our sinfulness certainly falls under the umbrella of "original sin" mentioned above. Happy Father's Day, Dads! God's blessings and Good health as we continue to flatten that curve!

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE



Check your temperature: if you have one, please do not come to church.



Stay home if you are ill.



Make sure you have a face covering to bring and wear.



Remember to bring your registration if you are not already on a list of attendees.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE



Enter only in marked doorways.



Wait patiently to be checked in by greeter.



Keep your face covering or mask on at all times except for receiving Communion.



Sanitize your hands as directed by greeter.



Observe social distancing at all times (look for marks on the floor).



Ushers will direct you to pews with markings showing where to sit.



Since there will be no passing of baskets for your offering please leave your offering in the boxes provided at the entrance and exit areas.

DURING THE SERVICE



Do not change seats during a service.



There will be no passing of offering baskets.



No physical sign of peace will be exchanged during Mass.



Follow instructions for Communion:

- Leave your seat only when directed by usher or greeter.
- Maintain six feet social distancing in the Communion line – look for marks on the floor.
- When 12 feet or two people away from the priest, sanitize your hands using the sanitizer from the usher. After sanitizing do not touch any surfaces.
- Approach the priest only after you are called forward. DO NOT remove your face covering.
- Extend a single hand to receive the Host.
- After moving six feet to the right or left, remove your mask and consume the Host.
- Replace your face covering or mask.
- Follow instructions to return to your pew.

Do not congregate outside the church doors.



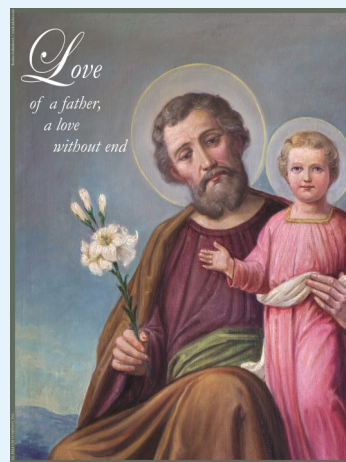
Continue to wear your face covering or mask until you leave the area where worshipers are.

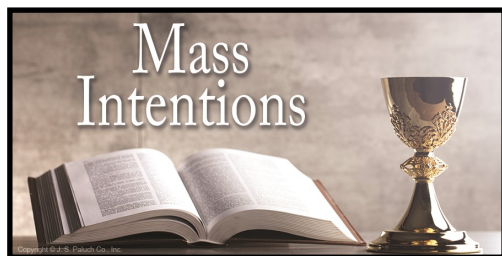
