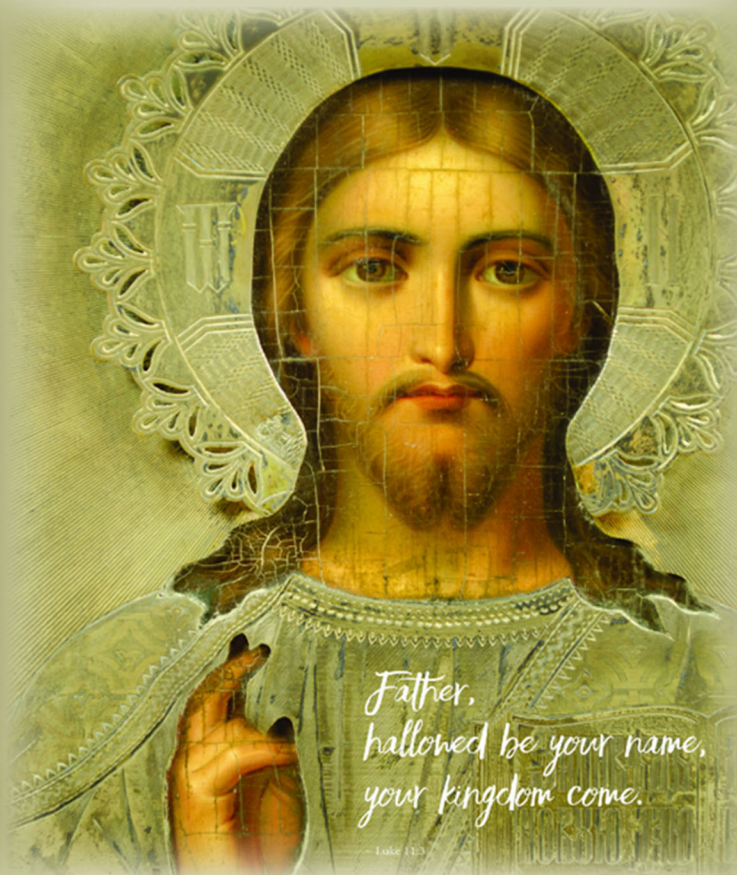

Dear Parishioners,

(Perhaps you noticed the large banner in the narthex (gathering space) of the church.) Bishop Andrew P. Wypych will be the main celebrant. Enjoy the summer! — Father Mike Meany

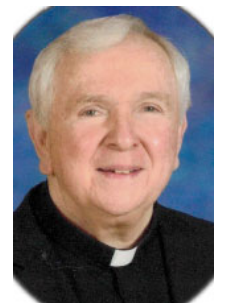


NOTE FROM FATHER MARC: THANKS FOR YOUR PRAYERS!

Due to my heart condition, I have been "pacemaker-dependent" since 1998 (i.e., atrial fibrillation). When it came time, therefore, to replace the pacemaker/battery unit in June this year, I thought it would be a routine procedure. However, the newly-implanted unit in my chest became infected, and I had to enter Christ Hospital last week to: 1) have the old unit removed, and 2) to clear up the infection that developed around it. I was hospitalized there for about a week for that procedure to take place.

During that time, it was decided to implant a new state-of-the-art "Medtronic Micra Transcatheter Pacemaker" instead of the older and more traditional unit. This surgical procedure took place through the groin area where the unit was injected into my artery and then into my heart where it remains. This procedure is indeed state-of-the-art since the unit is about the size of your thumbnail and the battery therein lasts from 8-10 years!

According to my doctor, I have to rest for awhile and will eventually go back to a "lighter work schedule." I want to acknowledge all the good doctors and nurses who helped clear up my infection, my GP—Dr. Paul MacFarlane, my Cardiologist—Dr. Paul Silverman, and especially Dr. Stephen Phillips who implanted my new pacemaker device! Also, I want to thank all of you (including Fr. Mike and Fr. Chris) for your prayers and well-wishes! I hope to see you soon around the parish once again. **May God bless you all!!**

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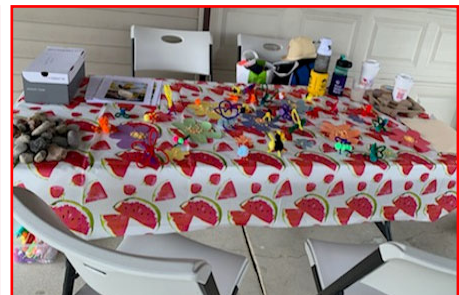

CONVERSATION WITH GOD

Prayer is our focus this weekend. In the Gospel, Jesus gives his disciples, and us, the Lord's Prayer, which we have cherished through the centuries. The first two words encompass much about our faith—unity among all Christians (Our), and a sense that we are in a deeply bonded relationship with God (Father).

In Genesis, we see Abraham in conversational prayer, in his creaturely humility before his Creator, seeking mercy and compassion for the innocent. The psalm is a lyrical prayer of thanksgiving and praise for the God who answered the sincere prayers of a people who had called out for help, showing them mercy. In Luke's Gospel, the disciples want to pray like Jesus, with the same intimacy—to experience God as Abba in the depths of their being.

Do we try to talk to God? Do we listen for answers? This relationship is always a work in progress.

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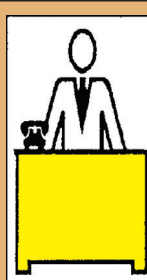
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
