St. Patricia Parish Mass Reservation System

We are very excited to be able to resume Daily and Weekend Masses. Thank you to all our volunteers who make reopening possible! There will be a capacity limit in place of no more than 120 attendees in the Church until further notice. **Masks Are Mandatory.** Please bring your own to wear in the building.

You must have a reservation in order to attend Mass. Mass Reservations will close on Fridays at noon. We will open reservations on Tuesdays at 9am for Weekend and Weekday Masses.

We are required by the Illinois Department of Health to keep a record of all attending Mass in the event of a positive Covid-19 case being present. After 14 days, all records are destroyed to protect privacy.

Please note the dispensation from Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation continues. The Archdiocese of Chicago still advises that the elderly and those with underlying medical conditions stay at home and participate through livestreamed and televised Masses. 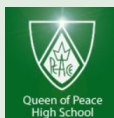

HOMILY FOR THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER: MAY 8/9, 2021

My memories on this weekend go back forty-seven years ago to my ordination at St. Mary of the Lake Seminary in Mundelein. It was a stormy and rain-driven morning as 34 of us—the ordination class of 1974—lined up to be made priests through the imposition of hands by John Cardinal Cody. Our first blessings had to be transferred to the gym because of the thunderstorms and our family and friends were waiting for us as we marched to the gym ecstatic and proud to greet them. My fondest memory was seeing my mother kneeling before me to receive her son's first blessing with my dad close behind her! Her dream for me and my dream for her merged—as her only child now a priest of God—blessed her and embraced her in a lovingly embrace!



I mention this milestone in my life today as we celebrate Mother's Day and the great love that God bestows upon us through the gift of mothers who nurture and care for us, who guide us and place us on the right path in life, who share in our dreams as well in our hardship and our pain! This moment of Mary's loving embrace for her Son Jesus is memorialized in Michelangelo's magnificent sculpture THE PIETA. Christ reminds his apostles of His undying love for them in the Farewell Discourse found today in John's Gospel. Jesus says, "If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love."

As Christ prepares to leave His apostles (the Ascension), He prays for His followers who will no doubt be up against great opposition as they spread the Gospel message entrusted to them—and to the Church! His "Discourse" (as scholars call it) is filled with three distinct prayers for them. One is that His followers live in loving communion with Him, the Father, and the Holy Spirit. Christ's second prayer is that the apostles continue to be "joyful" in their vocation ("My joy may be in you and your joy be complete."). Finally, His third prayer is that His followers not regard themselves as "slaves" but continue to be "His friends:" "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends....I call you now my friends since I have told you everything I have heard from my Father."

Jesus showed His great love for us sinners as He laid down His life. "No greater love hath a man than to lay down one's life for His followers, His friends"--- much like a mother who would gladly lay down her life for her children! John, in his epistle, touches on this kind of spiritual love. "Beloved, let us love one another because love is of God; everyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God. Whoever is without love does not know God, for God is love." In the common parlance of our society today, "love" means something entirely different! Love often signifies emotional attachment or romantic attraction. But, here, it is the moral imperative that is life-giving—much like a mother's love! This kind of love is never completely achieved, but gradually revealed in the service and care of the faith community: "they will know we are Christians by our love!"

The unexpected power of this love is exhibited in the excerpt from Acts today. Peter traveled to the home of Cornelius with some of the circumcised believers from Joppa who are surprised by the receptivity to the faith from the Gentile converts there. Peter, for his part, has received a premonition in a dream and proclaims, "In truth, I see that God shows no partiality. Rather in every nation whoever fears Him and acts uprightly is acceptable to Him." For Peter, this is a major breakthrough—admitting that all Gentiles (namely, the uncircumcised) can by nature of their baptism receive the Holy Spirit! He hears them "speaking in tongues and glorifying God—and orders them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ!"



And, so on this Mother's Day weekend, we give thanks to God for our mothers—those who have given us a glimpse into what true, genuine and unconditional love is! During this holy season of "Eastertime," we also give thanks to God for the gift of faith that leads us to an understanding of the Paschal Mystery—the Loving Passion and Death and Resurrection—and ultimately Ascension of Our Lord!

FATHER'S DAY MASS ENROLLMENT



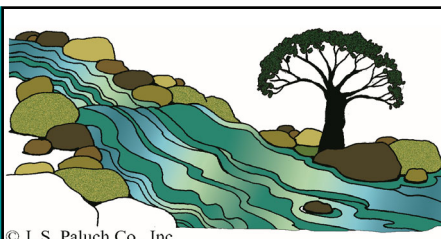

COVID-19 Vaccinations Available to Homebound Individuals

Pathlights, formerly known as PLOWS Council on Aging, is partnering with AgeOptions and the Cook County Department of Public Health (CCDPH) to provide in-home COVID-19 vaccinations for suburban Cook County residents who are unable to leave home due to age, disability, or medical impairment.*

To be eligible for this program you must live in the jurisdiction of CCDPH (all of Cook County except for Chicago, Skokie, Evanston, Oak Park and Stickney) and:

Be a senior (65+) OR a person with a disability who requires in-home assistance.	OR Have to use adaptive equipment (like a ventilator, crutches, a walker, a wheelchair, etc.) and/or accessible transportation to leave home.	AND Leaving home is not an option for you because doing so requires considerable and taxing effort.
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*NOTE: The quickest way to get a vaccine is to participate in a vaccination clinic outside of the home. There are options for drive-through clinics where no additional walking is required. To see other vaccination options visit <https://vaccine.cookcountyl.gov/> or call 833-308-1988.

If you or someone you know fits the criteria, you can sign-up by calling the Vaccine Sign-Up Hotline: 833-308-1988 M-F 7am-10pm and Sat 8a-10pm CT or <http://bit.ly/homevaccine>

After sign-up, you will receive a confirmation email or phone call from one of CCDPH's COVID-19 Vaccine Provider Partners to schedule your in-home vaccination when the vaccine is available to you. Please be patient as we respond to a large number of requests. As always, we are available should you have questions.
