FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

STAFF DAY — This past Wednesday, the Core Staff gathered for a day of prayer and planning as we look to the year ahead. We are not trying to make more work, but to work smarter and more creatively as we look to the future. Hopefully, as a parish, our efforts in building new relationships and reflecting on our ministries will foster greater vitality and faith development.

The first part of the day focused on The “Renew My Church” (RMC) Initiative and its implications for St. Patricia. The evening will permit me to become acquainted with all of you and understand how best we can begin to implement the RMC goals and objectives. Remember, these first steps will take time to become an integral part of the parish culture. I am sure you have heard the wise saying: “Rome wasn’t built in day!” With this being said, we have to start somewhere and be patient as we move through the ups and downs, which is part of any major endeavor.

INSTALLATION MASS — I am pleased to announce that my Installation Mass will be on Saturday, October 2, at the 4:00 p.m. Mass. Bishop Andrew Wypych will be the presider. A reception will follow. More information will be forthcoming.

Finally, I want you to know that in the little time I am with you, I find your support of St. Patricia Parish and School as truly amazing and a concrete way in which you build the Kingdom of God right here in our own country and in our own time.

Amid so much uncertainty, pain and conflict that we have witnessed in these past few months and weeks, Catholic faith communities like ours are ensuring that prayer, sacrifice and hope never dies. 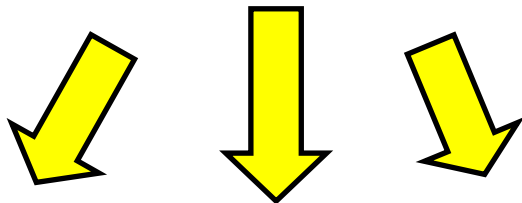
NOT ABLE TO ATTEND MASS ?

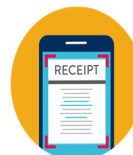

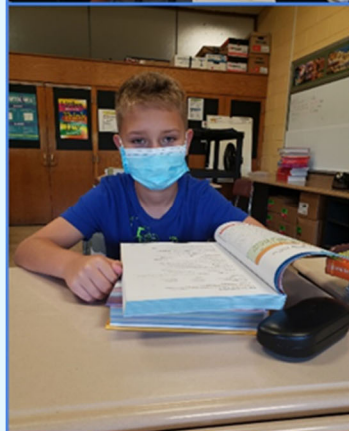

Children must be baptized. The Archdiocese requires the children to take part in a two-year preparation program for the Sacraments of Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation.

Do you offer any classes for Teens who are in need of receiving Sacraments?

Yes, they may register for our **Teen RCIA Program**. It is a one-year program which runs from September through March. Classes will be held on Tuesday evenings from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm.

Do you offer any program for Adults who are in need of receiving Sacraments?

Yes, they may register for our **Adult RCIA Program**. It is a one-year program which runs from October through March or April. Classes will be held on Monday evenings.

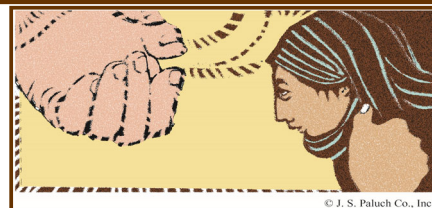
