From our Pastor...

After a "hibernation" of nearly ten weeks now because of the coronavirus, we're all ready for a "REOPENING"! We're all anxious to either go to the shopping mall or out to eat at our favorite restaurant or attend a baseball game (I know I certainly am)! And from what I have surmised by the notes and phone calls I have received during these past weeks of lockdown and social distancing, many of you are anxious to return to church to attend Mass and to receive the sacraments! Many have expressed a "real hunger" for the time when you will be able to 'safely' return to St. Patricia and to receive the Eucharist once again!



The operative and significant word here is "SAFELY". There have been innumerable protests throughout the country (as well as in our own state of Illinois) against the Governor's orders to remain at home in order to stop the spread of this terrible virus. News reports indicate parties taking place in the city (young people have even been congregating from time to time in our parking lot). We don't know what exactly the "new normal" will look like in terms of persons coming together to a theater or a ballpark or to church! This we do know: that we need to proceed cautiously and gradually in our reopening efforts. Our moral theology guidelines always stress taking the "safer course" when human life is at stake.....especially since our medical experts warn us about a potential second outbreak down the road.

We've been reminded constantly during these days that "We're all in this together....and that we'll get through it together....to the other side". We need to keep our spirits high while helping out the elderly and those most in need. We need to make some sacrifices—even if that means we curtail our freedoms a little while longer, even if it means we delay our reopening until our medical experts say it's okay. We need to trust in our faith in the Lord Who tells us in this week's Gospel: "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Have faith in God, have faith also in me." (JN 14:1-2). Jesus goes on to remind us that "I am the way and the truth and the life" and that He calls us a deeper relationship with His Father through Him!

In conclusion, I would like to thank all of you who have remembered Father Peter and I with cards and calls (and some delicious home-cooked meals too). This past week we celebrated our anniversary of priestly ordination (Fr.Peter: 65 years and I: 46 years). Both of us celebrate Mass each day in our school/house chapel and we pray for all of you—especially all of those affected by this virus and the medical personnel who work with them. This weekend is, of course, MOTHER'S DAY and we'll pray for all of you who are moms as well as all of our mothers living and dead who nurtured us in our Christian faith! Be patient. Be kind. Be strong.



TODAY'S READINGS

Celebrating the Month of Mary

The month of May is a special time for us Catholics to pay homage to our Blessed Mother Mary.

Pray the Rosary

It is traditional in this month to pray the Rosary at home within the family. The restrictions of the pandemic have made us come to appreciate all the more this "family" aspect, also from a spiritual point of view. For this reason, Pope Francis is encouraging everyone to rediscover the beauty of praying the Rosary at home in the month of May.

Make your own Marian shrine

This is a particularly fun activity to do outside, if you have an outdoor statue of the Blessed Mother, but it can easily be done inside as well. The flowers may not exactly be blooming yet, but you can explore the yard with the kids and see what kind of rustic natural bouquets you can create to decorate the shrine. Find some rocks to paint with Marian symbols or make paper garland to hang and write prayer intentions on it. Don't get intimidated by the word "shrine" or hung up on the idea of a "grotto." The idea is simply to create a spot where the kids will feel comfortable taking a break from their play to "visit Mary" for a few quiet moments.

Have a May crowning

If you have a statue of the Blessed Mother, create a makeshift crown using whatever materials you might have on hand. And though we aren't able to take to the streets en masse these days, why not plan your own mini Marian procession around the house or the yard? Building a simple float, sing songs like "Salve Regina" and finish up with a tasty treat.
