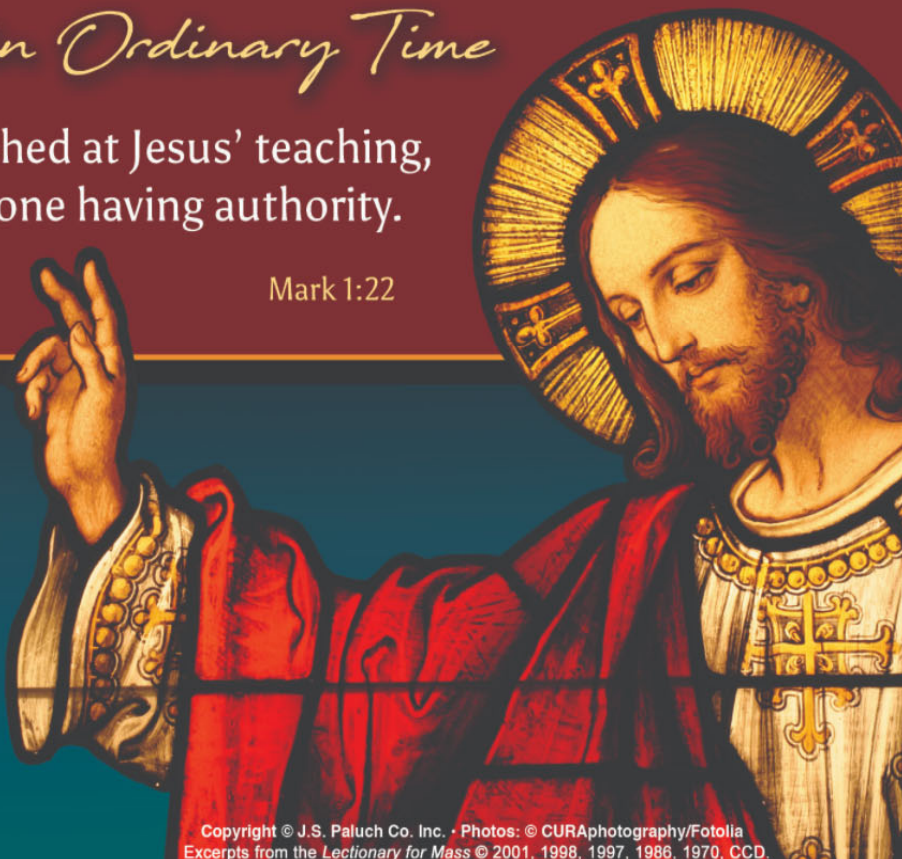

St. Patricia Parish Mass Reservation System

We are very excited to be able to resume Daily and Weekend Masses. Thank you to all our volunteers who make reopening possible! There will be a capacity limit in place of no more than 120 attendees in the Church until further notice. **Masks Are Mandatory.** Please bring your own to wear in the building.

You must have a reservation in order to attend Mass. Mass Reservations will close on Fridays at noon. We will open reservations on Tuesdays at 9am for Weekend and Weekday Masses.

We are required by the Illinois Department of Health to keep a record of all attending Mass in the event of a positive Covid-19 case being present. After 14 days, all records are destroyed to protect privacy.

HOMILY FOR THE THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: January 23/24, - 2021

According to Archdiocesan guidelines during the pandemic, Eucharistic celebrations should be no longer than 35 minutes long and the priest's homily about 5-6 minutes in length. Therefore, my remarks have been short and concise, always relevant to the Scripture message of that weekend. This understanding of "clocked time"—the time we follow on our wrist watches is referred to as "Chronos." It is the "clock-watching" a student does during what seems like a "long boring" class in school or the time a worker punches on the time-clock before he goes home! A second type of time for ancient man was "Kairos"—when we are presented at a significant moment in our lives with a memorable life-changing experience: we refer to this phenomena often as "time standing still" (i.e., the birth of a child, when you first meet and fall in love, when some tragic or historical happening takes place like an earthquake, assassination, etc.). Ecclesiastes speaks of "a time to be born, a time to die, a time to sow and a time to reap..."

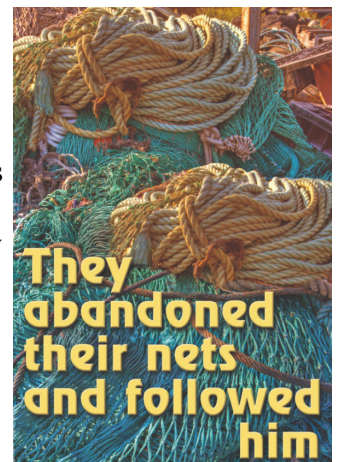
Besides understanding "time" as either "Chronos" or "Kairos," for the Christian there is a third type of time referred to as the "eschaton:" when Christ will come at the end of time to judge us all! At every Mass after the Consecration we say, "Christ has died, Christ is risen. Christ will come again!" This kind of time can be compared to a sports competition with a "running clock" like in football, basketball, or hockey. The time is flashing by quickly toward a final happening or final score that will determine the outcome of the contest.

Paul in Corinthians today says, "I tell you, brothers and sisters, that time is running out....From now on, let those having wives act as not having them, those weeping as not weeping, those rejoicing as not rejoicing...for the world in its present form is passing away." What Paul is doing is describing Christ's coming at the end of time (what the church called the "Parousia") as a time both of fulfillment and reward, a time of reckoning and accountability. With this in mind, therefore, the way I spend my present daily life takes on a new perspective. There is now a sense of urgency to hear God's Word and to do the Work of the Lord! Nothing should stand in the way—neither marriage, nor business, nor personal matters!

That same sense of urgency is evident here in the call of the apostles in Mark's Gospel---Simon and Andrew, James and John Zebedee---all of whom leave their nets behind to follow Christ! Notice that Jesus' ministry follows after John's arrest. The Baptist's message about the coming of the kingdom that calls each of us to repentance and conversion of heart is now "taken up" by Christ as he assembles His ministry team. Following Jesus demands much more than a new perspective on life, however, it demands a radical renunciation of one's former life and total dedication to Christ and the Kingdom!

It is similar to the call that Jonah receives: to proclaim a message of repentance to the people of Nineveh. We are told that it is an enormously large city that takes three days to get through. Jonah announces quite reluctantly, "Forty days more and Nineveh will be destroyed!" At first, he is hesitant about preaching the Word of God to the people. The crowds, however, after hearing his barely audible mutterings respond wholeheartedly! The king even proclaims a fast—and a city of 120,000 people have been converted. Yahweh, we clearly see, uses at times the most unlikely persons to spread His message!

As true and faithful disciples, we have recently witnessed senseless violence in our streets with many carjackings and killings! We have also witnessed "civil unrest" (Black Lives Matter marches as well as the storming of the Capitol building). We have observed many "natural disasters" like floods, fires, tornados, and hurricanes. And, finally, we have lived through this past year our share of pestilence and famine with the coronavirus and its effect on our economy. Are these signs that the "END" is near? Is Christ's "Coming Again" imminent (what the early Christians called the "Parousia")? The urgency and immediacy of the running clock---and the God-given gift of time---will only tell!



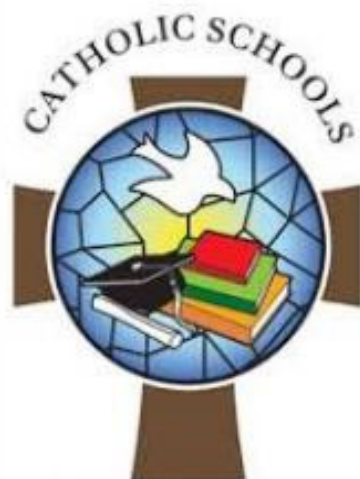

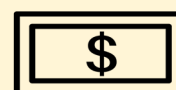

Tax Credit Scholarship Program

Instructions on How to Make a Donation at MyTax.Illinois.Gov

Part 1 - Request a Letter ID – In order to donate you'll need an account on mytax.illinois.gov. This requires your Social Security Number and Driver's License Number. The Letter ID will be mailed to your address on file from last year's Illinois 1040.

Part 2 – Create & Activate an Account – Once you receive the Letter ID in the mail, you will log in to mytax.illinois.gov and click the button to create and activate an account. You'll need your Social Security Number, Driver's License Number, and Letter ID code.

Part 3 - Apply for the Tax Credit – Once you create & activate the account, you'll receive an email with a special code you'll need to enter the first time you log into your account. Now you're ready to donate.

Part 4 - Download Certificate of Authorized Contribution and make your donation to a non-profit Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) –

Donate to Empower Illinois SGO – www.empowerillinois.org/donors/

Part 5 – Download a Certificate of Receipt (COR) – Follow the instructions to download documentation of your donation for your tax files.

Part 6 - Receive your Credit – Your tax credit will be applied when you file your 2018 Illinois income taxes which will either eliminate or reduce your tax liability.
