From our Pastor...

Quite appropriately this Sunday as we reopen our parish here at St. Pat's, we celebrate the feast of **CORPUS CHRISTI (MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST)**. Our restaurants and stores, our parks and golf courses begin slowly to open for customers while the weather feels more and more like summer with temperatures in the '80's and '90's. We who have 'hibernated' nearly three months now look forward to seeing other people—friends, neighbors, parishioners. We look forward to being outdoors and active, participating and praying together. The scripture readings this weekend speak to us clearly on that theme.

DEUTERONOMY: “Even though the Israelites wander forty years in the desert, Yahweh feeds and takes care of His People.” The Jews grumble and complain to Moses since they are made to journey in the desert—only to be reminded that it was Yahweh Who delivered them from Egypt and provides ‘manna’ for them now to eat. Many of us having been afflicted with ‘cabin fever’ the last three month, are beginning to grumble about the duration of the coronavirus pandemic. We need to be reminded to trust in God: that He has provided for us thus far and will deliver us (soon)!

1 CORINTHIANS: “The Church at Corinth, beset by division and conflict and the predominance of idolatry, needs to come together in a tighter, more holy brotherhood” Paul challenges the community of faithful to KOINONIA which means a truer fellowship and sharing made possible by the reception of the Eucharist together at the Lord’s table. “The cup of blessing that we bless....the bread that we break is it not a participation in the blood and body of Christ?” During our time of home confinement one of our mantras has been: “We are in this together although we are separate!” Now we need to come together once again at Mass as a parish family of faith!

JOHN: “The Jews (who adhere to strict dietary laws) are flabbergasted to hear that Jesus wants to give them His Flesh to eat and His Blood to drink.” The only way to enter into a true and lasting relationship with the Father and the Spirit is to share in the food/ meal in which Jesus invites us to partake namely the Mass. Jesus tells us, “I am the living bread come down from heaven, whoever eats this bread will live forever...” This is one of the great mysteries of our Catholic faith: Corpus Christi—the sacramental Presence of Our Lord with us in the Church until the end of time! Reception of His Body—not only replaces the manna of the OT but perfects it and makes us more holy and kind and caring toward all men and women (of all races and nationalities and ethnic origins)!

As we reopen our church this weekend, we thank you in advance for your patience and co-operation as we follow the new guidelines for participation in the Eucharist. Don’t forget to: **SIGN UP ONLINE** (Signup-Genius) or **CALL THE RECTORY: CAPACITY LIMITED TO 90 PER MASS.....WEAR A MASKSANITIZE YOUR HANDS IN THE GATHERING SPACE....SIT IN A PEW THAT HAS BEEN MARKED WITH A ‘X’ (for social distancing).....FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS OF OUR REOPENING COMMITTEE/ VOLUNTEERS...**

Let’s pray for peace and fellowship, justice and understanding among all God’s children on this feast of Corpus Christi!

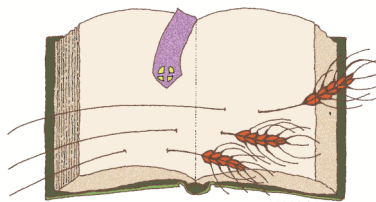

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE



Check your temperature: if you have one, please do not come to church.



Stay home if you are ill.



Make sure you have a face covering to bring and wear.



Remember to bring your registration if you are not already on a list of attendees.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE



Enter only in marked doorways.



Wait patiently to be checked in by greeter.



Keep your face covering or mask on at all times except for receiving Communion.



Sanitize your hands as directed by greeter.



Observe social distancing at all times (look for marks on the floor).



Ushers will direct you to pews with markings showing where to sit.



Since there will be no passing of baskets for your offering please leave your offering in the boxes provided at the entrance and exit areas.

DURING THE SERVICE



Do not change seats during a service.



There will be no passing of offering baskets.



No physical sign of peace will be exchanged during Mass.



Follow instructions for Communion:

- Leave your seat only when directed by usher or greeter.
- Maintain six feet social distancing in the Communion line – look for marks on the floor.
- When 12 feet or two people away from the priest, sanitize your hands using the sanitizer from the usher. After sanitizing do not touch any surfaces.
- Approach the priest only after you are called forward. DO NOT remove your face covering.
- Extend a single hand to receive the Host.
- After moving six feet to the right or left, remove your mask and consume the Host.
- Replace your face covering or mask.
- Follow instructions to return to your pew.

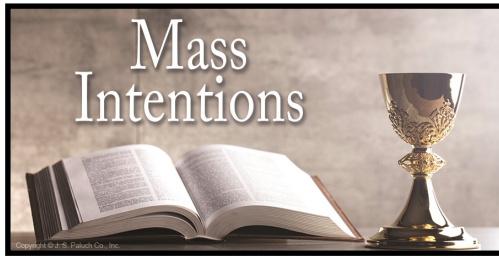

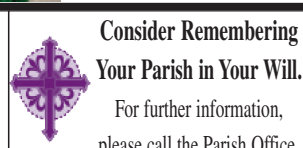
