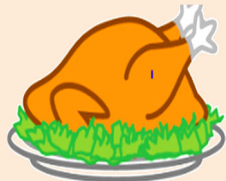
COMMUNITY SERVICES THANKSGIVING

PARISH REGISTRATION DRIVE: New and Current

We are in the midst of “Renew My Church” across the Archdiocese of Chicago which involves the process of “grouping” parishes in an outgoing procedure of evaluating how we may better serve our Catholics’ spiritual needs in light of the shortage of available priests and dwindling financial resources.

We here at St. Patricia we have been grouped with three other parishes: Sacred Heart in Palos Hills, St. Linus in Oak Lawn, and Our Lady of the Ridge in Chicago Ridge. The pastors of these parishes have already met a number of times and in subsequent months, the staffs will meet together and then the Parish Councils and leadership Boards. This process will go on until Spring of 2021.

We need to present “recent data” concerning our Mass attendance (which will be reflected in our October count), our weekly offertory collection, and the number of registered families we have in our parish faith community.

We have simplified the “parish census form” into a one-page survey for your convenience. WE ASK THAT YOU FILL OUT AN UPDATED FORM FOR US WHETHER YOU LIVE HERE 30 YEARS OR ARE A NEWLY-REGISTERED PARISHIONER. Forms are available on our website or in the back of church. IF YOU CARE ABOUT THE FUTURE OF THIS PARISH, WE NEED YOU TO FILL OUT THIS CENSUS FORM so that we can bring our updated numbers to the grouping meetings. Our goal is 2,500 registered families!

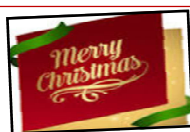

Today's reading from the book of Wisdom presents an image of a patient God who "rebuke[s] offenders little by little" (Wisdom 12:2), an image endorsed by the psalmist, singing of how the LORD is "slow to anger and of great kindness, and compassionate toward all his works" (Psalm 145:8, 9). The crowd with Jesus, however, grumbles when they see Jesus's kindness and compassion extended to Zacchaeus, who was not just a tax collector, but the "chief tax collector"—a title that surely emphasizes his standing as a sinner to be scorned. In the second reading, Saint Paul urges the Thessalonians to be "worthy" of God's calling, so that "the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you" (2 Thessalonians 1:12); such people, unlike the crowd in the Gospel, would rejoice at Zacchaeus's determination to change his life after encountering Jesus.
